RESPONSE TO STATEMENT BY CHAIRPERSON COMMITTEE ON LANDS, URBAN PLANNING AND HOUSING HONOURABLE AMRIYA JUMA ON THE STATUS OF PLOT NO. 830 IN JUNDA/MTOPANGA WARD

Honourable Amriya Juma Boy, Chairperson Committee on Lands, Urban Planning and Housing.

Hon. Amriya Juma: Thank you very much Mr. Speaker. I rise to respond to the Statement that was brought forward by Honourable Kai (Flames) from Junda Ward about the Status of Plot No. MN/11/830 in Junda of Mtopanga Ward. Mr. Speaker, this is hereby the response. The said plot was originally registered as a Plot Number 830/2/MN and it measures about 354.4 acres as per the survey documents. According to the department records in the County E-Land system, the plot No. MN/2/830 is privately owned by Pioneer Jozezum Co. Ltd. A portion of this land was sub divided into several sub plots and finally the Vikwatani Health Facility is situated within the said plot and occupied an area approximately 0.12 hectares. It should be noted that during the sub division there were sub plots that were earmarked for public utilities, thereby giving authority for building the Health Facility. So, I think Mr. Speaker the concern of the Honourable Member was that the same method that was used to build Vikwatani Health Centre should also be used to build a Facility in Junda Ward because it is the same 830/MN/2. So according to this report Mr. Speaker it appears that there are several plots that had been highlighted for public utilities, so it is in this accordance maybe the Honourable Member can take it up and ensure that we have also a parcel of land that is in Junda Ward under 830 to also surface the Health facility in this area thank you very much.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you. Honourable Member from Junda Ward?

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT BY MEMBER OF COUNTY ASSEMBLY FOR MWAKIRUNGE HONOURABLE
MWINYI MTOTO ON SECURITY OF COUNTY HEALTH FACILITIES

Honourable Mwinyi Mtoto, MCA Mwakirunge Ward.

Hon. Mwinyi Mtoto: Thank you Mr. Speaker. Mr. Speaker Sir, Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order No.41(2) (c), I wish to request a statement from the Chairperson, Committee on Health regarding the security of the County Health Facilities. Honourable Speaker, the security of health facilities within Mombasa County remains a great concern due to increases in cases of vandalism, theft and unauthorized access. This has not only led to damage and loss of essential medical equipment but has caused risks to health care workers and patients. Honourable Speaker, in light of this concern, I urge the Chairperson of the Committee on Health to request the County Executive Committee member for Health to:

- 1. Provide a comprehensive report on the current security status of all County Health Facilities*
- 2. Outline any existing measures in place to prevent vandalism and enhance security.*
- 3. Provide information on whether the County government has plans to construct perimeter walls around all County Health Facilities to improve security.*

4. *Clarify whether there are plans to deploy security personnel at each health facility to safeguard infrastructure, staff and the patients*

5. *Provide a timeline for the implementation of these security measures, if any.*

Honourable Speaker, securing our health facilities will ensure the protection of critical health infrastructure and enhance service delivery. I, therefore seek a timely response from the Committee to address this matter urgently. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwalimu): Yes, Chairperson Committee on Health?

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT FROM MEMBER OF COUNTY ASSEMBLY FOR MIKINDANI WARD
HONOURABLE JACTONE MADIALO ON OVERDUE RETIREMENT BENEFITS

Honourable Jactone Madialo, MCA Mikindani Ward?

Hon. Madialo: Ahsante sana Mheshimiwa Spika kwa kunipatia fursa hii. Kwanza kabla sijasoma hii taarifa ningependa kukaribisha ndugu zetu wakubwa, dada zetu wakubwa, wakubwa wetu na wengine pia wako na uwezo wa kuwa wazazi Waheshimiwa wengine kama Mheshimiwa huyu hapa ambaye nimekaa karibu na yeye. Karibuni sana na tunawapatia uhakikisho ya kwamba Jumba hili litasimama na nyinyi ili muweze kupata zile fedha zenu ambazo munadai Kaunti.

[Applause]

Honourable Speaker, I rise, pursuant to Standing Order 41-2C, to seek a statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on Finance, Budget, and Appropriations regarding the issue of overdue retirement benefits for staff who retired from service. Honourable Speaker, it has come to my attention that several former members of staff who retired as far back as 2020 are yet to receive their retirement benefits. This unfortunate situation has primarily been caused by non-remittance of statutory contributions by the County government of Mombasa which has resulted in undue hardship of these retirees who served this County diligently. Honourable Speaker, this matter demands urgent intervention to ensure that these former staff members receive their rightful dues without any further delay. It is imperative that the Chairperson Committee on Finance, Budget, and Appropriations investigates and provides a comprehensive report on the following.

1. *The status of all unremitted retirement contributions by the County Government*

2. *The reasons for the delay in processing retirement benefits for affected staff*
3. *The proposed measures to ensure prompt settlement of these overdue benefits and prevent future occurrences.*

Honourable Speaker, in light of the above, I urge the Chairperson to inquire into and report on this matter at the earliest possible opportunity. Thank you, Honourable Speaker. Thank you.

[Applause]

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you Honourable Jacktone Madialo, for bringing the concerns of the former County employees. Yes, Honourable Kibwana Swaleh Baya, any response?

Hon. Kibwana Swaleh: Ahsante Mheshimiwa Spika. Mheshimiwa Spika, nataka kwanza nimpongeze Mwenyekiti wa Kamati ya Ajira kwa kuleta swala hili na pia kusikitikia wazazi wetu ambao wamehudumia na nguvu zao zote na uwezo wao wote lakini mpaka leo wanalia kwa sababu hawajapata haki zao. Mheshimiwa Spika, mimi nikiwa mbele hapa nataka niseme ya kwamba nataka tushirikiane pamoja kuona kwamba hawa wazee waliokuja hapa hawakuja tu hapa lakini wamekuja wakijua wana watoto wao hapa ndani ya Bunge na pia ni haki yao kupata haki yao kama wale wengine wafanyikazi wengine. Kwa hivyo kwanza kabisa ni kuomba samahani kwamba tunaona mpaka sasa hamjashughulikiwa na wengine wameshughulika ki vyao pia kutafuta haki yao lakini hawajapata, ni kuwahakikishia kwamba Mheshimiwa Spika utanipa muda kupitia uongozi wa Jumba hili ikiwa Mheshimiwa Spika mwenyewe na uongozi wote kuona kwamba tunashirikiana na Kamati yangu ili mwaka huu iwe ndio mwisho ya wazee hawa kuzunguka kutafuta haki yao.

[Applause]

Mheshimiwa Spika hata tuna haya hapa wengine tukiwaangalia kwa sababu walikuwa hawastahili kufika hapa kupata kudai haki yao, lakini lisilo budi hutendwa. Kwa hivyo mimi nataka niseme kwamba utupatie muda wa wiki tatu ili tuone kwamba tumezama katika hili jambo, tumeweza kuita ofisi husika na pia watupe *timelines* yaani ni wakati gani hili jambo ikiwa watalimalizia tuweze kuleta ripoti kwa wazee wetu. Kwa hivyo pili tungewataka waheshimiwa kwani hili si jambo la mwenyekiti pekee ni jambo zito ambalo linataka kila mtu ashughulike na sisi ili wazee wetu wapate haki yao. Kwa hivyo wiki tatu tukishirikiana pamoja tuna imani *Insha-Allah* tutaweza kurudisha jibu kwa wazee wetu hali halisi ilivyo, Ahsante sana Mheshimiwa Spika.

[Applause]

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you Honourable Kibwana Swaleh. Yes, Honourable Jacktone Madialo are you satisfied with the time limit given by the Chair?

Hon. Madialo: Nashukuru sana Mheshimiwa Spika. Mheshimiwa Mwenyekiti wa Kamati ya Bajeti ya Fedha na Matumizi (Finance Budget and Appropriations) ameongea na hisia sana na naamini kwamba atalizamia jambo hili, kwa hivyo ninakubaliana naye kwamba kwa muda wa wiki tatu imetosha. Ahsante.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you. So, the Committee on Finance Budget and appropriations in three weeks' time we will wait for your response in this Honourable House on how or the report concerning the retirees their benefits and how they are going to be paid their benefits. Honourable Athman Rama Mwamwiri the Leader of Majority party, move the motion?

The Leader of Majority (Hon. Mwamwiri): Ahsante sana Mheshimiwa Spika. Mheshimiwa naomba kuleta Hoja ya Bunge hili kuafiki kwenda mapumzikoni kwa mujibu wa kanuni zetu za kudumu 25(3) leo hii na kuregelea katika vikao vyake siku ya Jumanne tarehe 15 mwezi wa nne mwaka 2025 kwa mujibu wa kalenda ya Bunge hili ya vikao vya kawaida. Nimuombe Mheshimiwa Kiongozi wa Walio Wachache katika Bunge hili kuweza kuafiki Hoja hii.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwalimu): Yes, Honourable Morgan?

The Leader of Minority (Hon. Matsaki): Thank you Honourable Speaker. I do support the Motion. Thank you.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwalimu): Honourable Members, I now propose a question that the Motion by Honourable Athman Mwamwiri on adjournment of the County Assembly be debated in this Honourable House.

[Question proposed and agreed to]

Yes, Honourable Athman Rama?

The Leader of Majority (Hon. Mwamwiri): Ahsante Mheshimiwa Spika. Mheshimiwa Spika ni kanuni zetu za Bunge ya kwamba lazima tutekeleze jukumu kwa mujibu wa Kalenda. Mheshimiwa Spika, ratiba tuliyoipitisha inaonyesha ya kwamba leo hii tunapaswa kwenda likizo fupi na kurudi tarehe 15 mwezi wa nne. Tofauti na hayo Mheshimiwa Spika lazima Bunge hili chini ya Kiti chako kuweza kuitisha kikao maalum lakini kwa mujibu wa sheria sisi kuanzia kesho hatupaswi kuendesha kikao cha Bunge kwa sababu ratiba yetu haituruhusu labda kuwe na dharura ili Kiti chako kiweze kuita kikao maalum. Kwa hivyo hii ni taratibu hatuna budi bali kutekeleza kwa sababu imetulazimu kisheria leo kwenda mapumziko; tunapokwenda mapumziko haya mafupi ni fursa pia sisi Waislamu Mheshimiwa Spika kuweza kujikurubisha na kupata wasaa zaidi kuweza kutekeleza ibada hii. Kwa bahati nzuri ni sadfa ya kwamba kipindi hiki hata ndugu zetu Wakristo katika funga ya Kwarisma wakijiandaa kusherekea sikukuu za Pasaka. Kwa hivyo pia wao kuna fursa ya wao kufunga; watakuwa wamepata fursa nzuri ya kutangamana na muumba wao katika ibada hii lakini ziada pia Mheshimiwa Spika ni kutekeleza majukumu yetu ya kurudi mashinani kushikamana na wananchi wetu kuwasaidia waliolemelewa hususan katika hali za kimaisha kipindi hichi cha saumu, kufunga nao, kufuturu nao, kuwa nao katika ibada ili mji wetu na taifa letu Mungu aweze kuridhia na kulitakabali. Niombe tu Waheshimiwa ya kwamba likizo hii si ya kulala ni likizo ya kuchuma kwa wananchi wetu lakini

pia kwa kuchuma kwa Mwenyezi Mungu. *Insha-Allah* Mwenyezi Mungu atakabali saumu zetu. Ahsante Mheshimiwa Spika.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you Leader of Majority. Yes, Honourable Mwaura?

Hon. Mwaura: Ahsante Mheshimiwa Spika kwa kunipa fursa nami nipate kuchangia Mswada huu ambao umeletwa na Kiongozi wa Walio Wengi katika Bunge. Mheshimiwa Spika Mswada huu unazungumza habari ya kwenda mapumzikoni kwa Waheshimiwa na ni kweli kama jinsi alivyotaja kuna ndugu zetu ambao ni Waislamu ambao wako katika saumu na Mheshimiwa Spika ni vyema tu tukiwapatia nafasi wapate nafasi ya kwenda kupumzika kukaa na wenzi wao na kuomba dua kwa ajili ya nchi yetu na kwa ajili pia hata mji wetu wa Mombasa. Kwa hivyo Mheshimiwa Spika naunga swala hili mkono na ninasema Ahsante.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you. Yes, Honourable Juma Mwalimu?

Hon. Juma Mwalimu: Ahsante sana Mheshimiwa Spika kwa kunipatia fursa hii. Kwanza kabisa nitambue wazee wangu walioko kule juu ya *gallery*; wale wazee ambao wametufanyia sisi mpaka tunajivunia kwa kufikia hapa kwa sababu ni wajomba zetu, kuna kina mama zetu pale na ni haki yao kupata kile ambacho wanastahili kupata. Vilevile Mheshimiwa Spika mimi nimesimama kuunga mkono hoja hii na kama tunavyojua sasa hivi tuko katika kipindi cha ibada na sisi kama Waislamu usiku hatulali tunachukua muda mwingi kuomba dua na kuomba maghfira ili tuweze kufutiwa dhambi na tuweze kumuomba Mwenyezi Mungu kwa wingi.

Hon. Juma Mwalimu: Na tuweze kumuomba Mwenyezi Mungu kwa wingi, kwa sisi Waislamu hii ni fursa muhimu sana kwetu sisi kwa sababu wa kujumuika na Waislamu wenzetu kwa ibada za mchana na za siku na vile vile pia tu kuenda likizo tutaweza kupata fursa pia ya kwenda kutafuta vipweto ili ndugu zetu Waislamu waweze kupata futari. Ahsante sana Mheshimiwa Spika.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Yes, Honourable Juma Manuari?

Hon. Juma Manuari: Ahsante sana Mheshimiwa Spika. Kwanza, nichukue nafasi hii kumshukuru Mwenyezi Mungu kwa siku ya leo; pili, nichukue nafasi hii kumpa pongezi ndugu yetu, Mwenyekiti wa Kamati ya Leba kwa kutuletea wazee wetu pale juu tukawaona mimi mwenye nilivyo hapa pia nilishtuka nafsi yangu nikasema duu! Leo itakuwaje leo? Lakini alivyo fafanulia yale yaliyoko ni jukumu la Mwenyekiti wa Fedha kuhakikisha wazee wetu haki yao inapatikana kama alivyo ahidi na sisi pia tutamwambia pia hatuna budi isipokua tutasimama na yeye kwa sababu pale pana wazee wetu, babu zetu, ndugu zetu na marafiki zangu, tena wengi sana ambao kila nikitembea wao ndio wa kwanza wananitekerenya kwa hili swala. Kwa hivyo mimi nawaombea Mungu tu, tutakua na nyinyi mpaka mwisho wa safari na tuhakikishe maana kwenye makaratasi yetu pia tunaona kuna wengine walituwacha pia haki itafika kwenye familia zao. Mheshimiwa Spika nimesimama kuunga mkono hoja ya ndugu yangu Kiongozi wa wengi, ndugu yangu Mheshimiwa Athman Mwamwiri kwa kuwa hivi sasa ni wakati mwafaka kwetu sisi Waislamu na wale wenzetu pia wasiokua Waislamu kwa kuwa pia nao wana subiria maombi makuu kutokana na kalenda yao ya dini yao. Kwa hivyo Mheshimiwa Spika sisi ni wakati mwafaka wa kwenda kupumzika angalau huu muda ukiisha turudi kwenye Bunge kwa sababu

wewe mwenye hua unatuona jana, tulilala sana hapa na sio twalala kwa sababu ya nini? Ni kwa sababu ya usiku tumekesha kuomba na kumuomba Mungu na kuombea nchi yetu na hatuna budi hivi sasa kwa kua kuwa tunalikunja jamvi mpaka mwezi unaokuja basi pia ni waambie Waheshimiwa wenzangu wale wakristo na wale Waislamu tukirudi kuomba pia tuwaombe wale wazee Mungu awape umri ili ile haki yao waipate kabla hawajaondoka. Kwa hayo mengi machache Mheshimiwa Spika ahsante sana.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you. Yes, Honourable Ibrahim Omondi?

Hon. Omondi: Thank you Mr. Speaker. Thank you very much. Mr. Speaker, first of all, I would like to acknowledge the elders before us who are at the public gallery. Mr. Speaker, what I would like to say is that it is only important we pray. Remember, this is the Holy Month of Ramadhan and all these activities are taking place within the Holy Month of Ramadhan. These elders are here today Mr. Speaker; Chairperson for the Finance Committee has promised us here and stated categorically that within three weeks we shall be able to get a very comprehensive answer for these particular elders who have stayed for a long time. Some of them are worn out, some of them are very old, Mr. Speaker and I am sure even some of them are not well physically and it is also good that they get their justice by getting what they are supposed to get because it is their right. Mr. Speaker, I want to also echo what the fellow Members have said about the Motion in the House about the adjournment, that it is very important we are human beings and it is very important for us also to get time so that we can rest and get prepared for the future errands. Mr. Speaker also, prayers move mountains and prayer is very important this Holy Month of Ramadhan where our Muslim brothers are doing their prayers. It is only good that we do justice that they have time with their families and even in the mosque so that they can pray. Finally, Mr. Speaker apart from the responsibility, apart from the objectives that we have been given as Members of the County Assembly in this particular Honourable House to do the three functions, representation, oversight, and legislation. It is also important that we also do the other part, where we sit with our electorate try to figure out some of the gaps that are observed in our Wards so that when we come back Mr. Speaker well prepared, bring them in the House and we can now be able to correct them when we come back next time. Therefore, I actually say yes to the Motion. Thank you Mr. Speaker.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Thank you. Yes, Leader of the Majority Party, please reply to your Motion.

The Leader of the Majority Party (Hon. Mwamwiri): Ahsante Mheshimiwa Spika. Mheshimiwa Spika nishukuru Waheshimiwa wenza kwa kuweza kuchangia na vile vile kuunga mkono Hoja hii kwa sababu ni Hoja ya kikanuni. Kwa hivyo tunawajibu wa kuitekeleza Mheshimiwa Spika lakini inapotokea dharura ya jambo linalo hitajia huduma zetu sisi kama wawakilishi tuko na tunapoitwa kwa vikao maalum siku zote tunapatikana, lakini pia majukumu haya ya Bunge mengine hutekelezwa chini ya Kamati; Kamati ziko huru kuendelea na shughuli zake tukiwa katika kipindi cha kuandaa bajeti pia ni wajibu wa Waheshimiwa kutangamana na wananchi na kuchangia yale ya msingi katika Bajeti zetu. Nawatakia Waheshimiwa wote likizo fupi yenye fanaka, faraja na furaha, swaumu zao ziweze kutakabaliwa na sikukuu zao zote mbili nina imani zitatekelezeka kabla ya kurudi hii ikiwemo sikukuu ya Eid na sikukuu ya Pasaka kabla ya kurudi vikao hivi; ziwe ni sikukuu zenye heri na fanaka na watu wakumbukane kualikana kwa sababu wale jamaa wa vipeto nawajua pia mialishi wanasubiria. Ahsante Mheshimiwa Spika.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Makarani): Honourable Members, as per the Motion it was brought under Standing Order No. 25(3). This Motion after debating no question is going to be put; it is a privilege to the Leader of Majority that the Motion Members will debate but no question will be put after it. So, Members the Motion by Honourable Athman Mwamwiri on adjournment of the County Assembly is adopted by this Honourable House.
