NOTICE OF MOTION**INSTALLATION OF LIGHT-EMITTING DIODE (LED) STREET LIGHTING IN CHANGAMWE WARD**

Hon. Odari: Thank you Hon. Speaker. Hon. Speaker, I beg to give notice of the following Motion entitled, Installation of Light-Emitting Diode (LED) Street lighting in Changamwe Ward.

(Hon. Odari moved the Motion)

THAT AWARE that street lighting is a mandate of the County government as provided under the Fourth Schedule Part Two (5) of the Constitution of the Republic of Kenya, 2010;

FURTHER AWARE that street lights provide numerous benefits, including but not limited to promoting security, improving safety for drivers, riders and pedestrian;

NOTING THAT most LED street lights are more durable, luminous and save power compared to the previous High Pressure Sodium (HSP) lights, there is a need to install these streets lights in changamwe;
