Hon. Katana: Thank you Mr. Speaker Sir. I beg to give the following Notice of Motion.

THAT AWARE THAT the national and county unemployment rates are at all times high of 40 per cent for Kenya and 44 per cent for Mombasa County;

FURTHER AWARE THAT many youths and women are affected by ravaging unemployment phenomenon due to lack of adequate technical skills required in the competitive job market or lack skills to self-employ themselves;

COGNIZANT THAT, the National Government has similar programs for the youth but is limited in scope and scale;

NOTING THAT, youth and women are great human capital resource which if well harnessed and deployed could spur economic growth and county progress;

FURTHER NOTING THAT, the massive training program should include life skills, ICT, cottage industries, entrepreneurship and other practical courses needed in the labour market;

CONCERNED THAT, if the ravaging unemployment and lack of technical skills is not seriously addressed at the county level, their risk surging unemployment, slow economic growth and attendant ripple effects and continuation of the social malaise;

I therefore urge the assembly to RESOLVE:

THAT the County government of Mombasa to establish a massive training and up skilling of technical skills programme for unemployed youth and women to address the skills gap and equip them for the competitive labour market and for self-employment.

THAT the County government to partner with private sector players and stakeholders to organize financial management, entrepreneurial, legal and other skills to build the capacity of our youths, tuk tuk and boda boda drivers.
